What is YEC?

A locally-organized event that brings students together to gain hands-on entrepreneurship experience. A 3-part entrepreneurship competition consisting of an executive summary, exhibition booth, and business pitch. Youth can compete as individuals or teams. A panel of judges, made up of local entrepreneurs, resource partners, and mentors, evaluate the students' work. Winners of the Shawnee County YEC continue on to the state-wide competition known as the Kansas Entrepreneurship Challenge (KEC) which is held at Kansas State University.

- Youth can prepare on their own or with other students at a work session
- Open to all Shawnee County 7th-12th graders
- Business pitched can be an idea or currently operational
